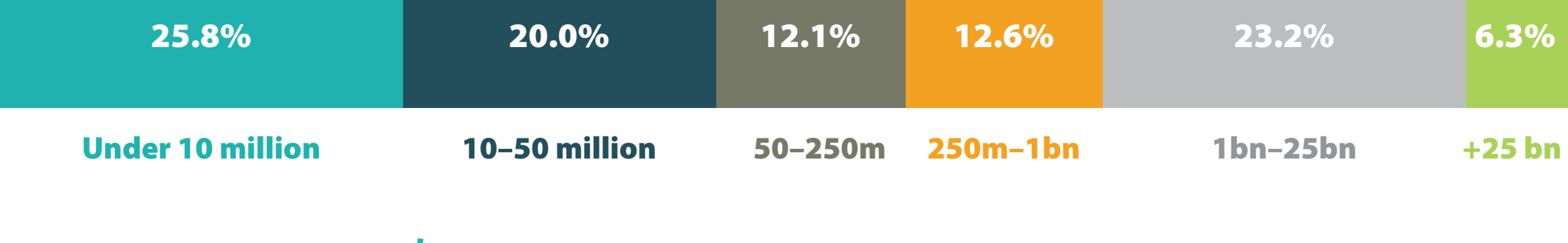


# The Future of Data Interchange

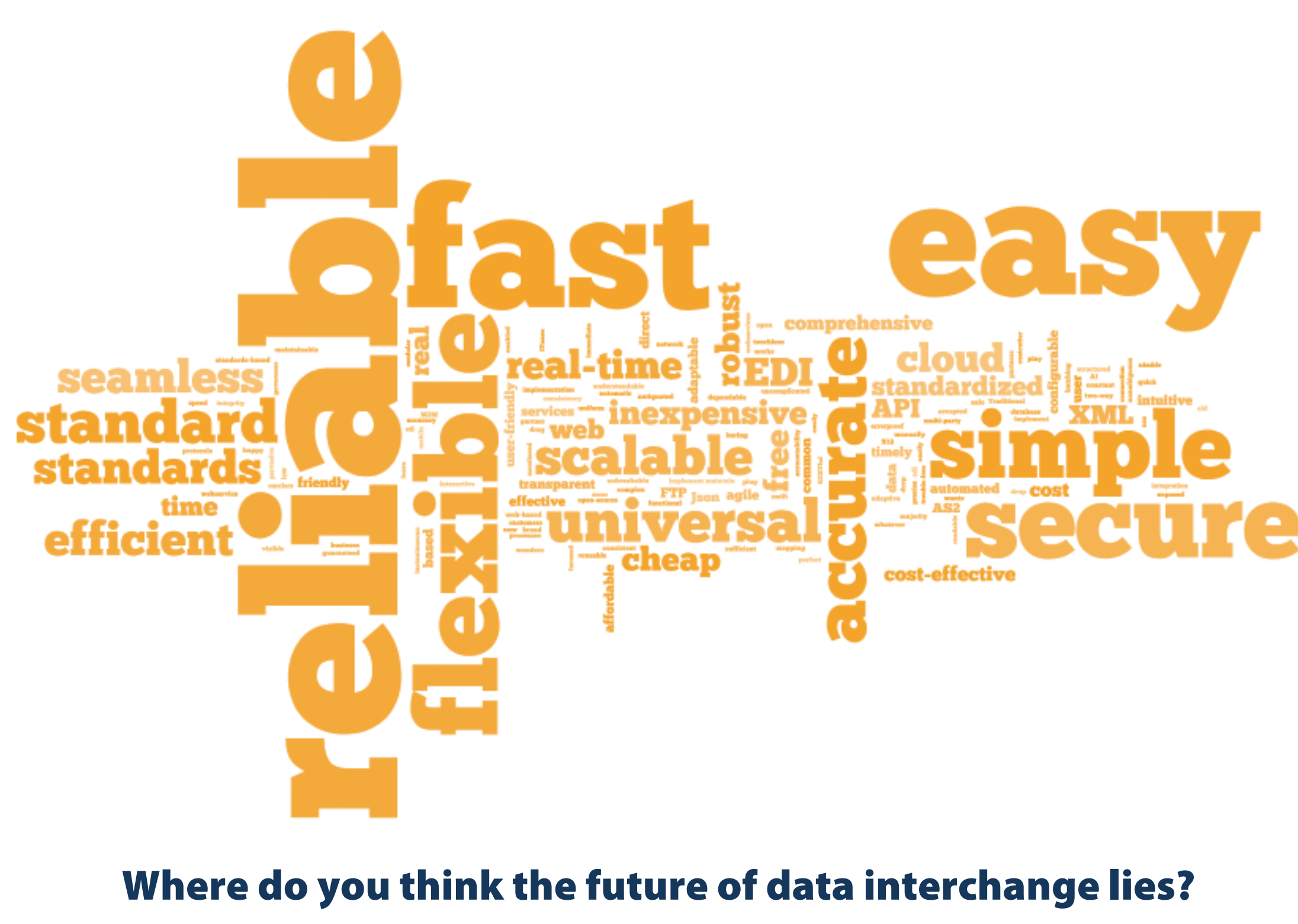
### Which platform are you using for your current EDI needs?



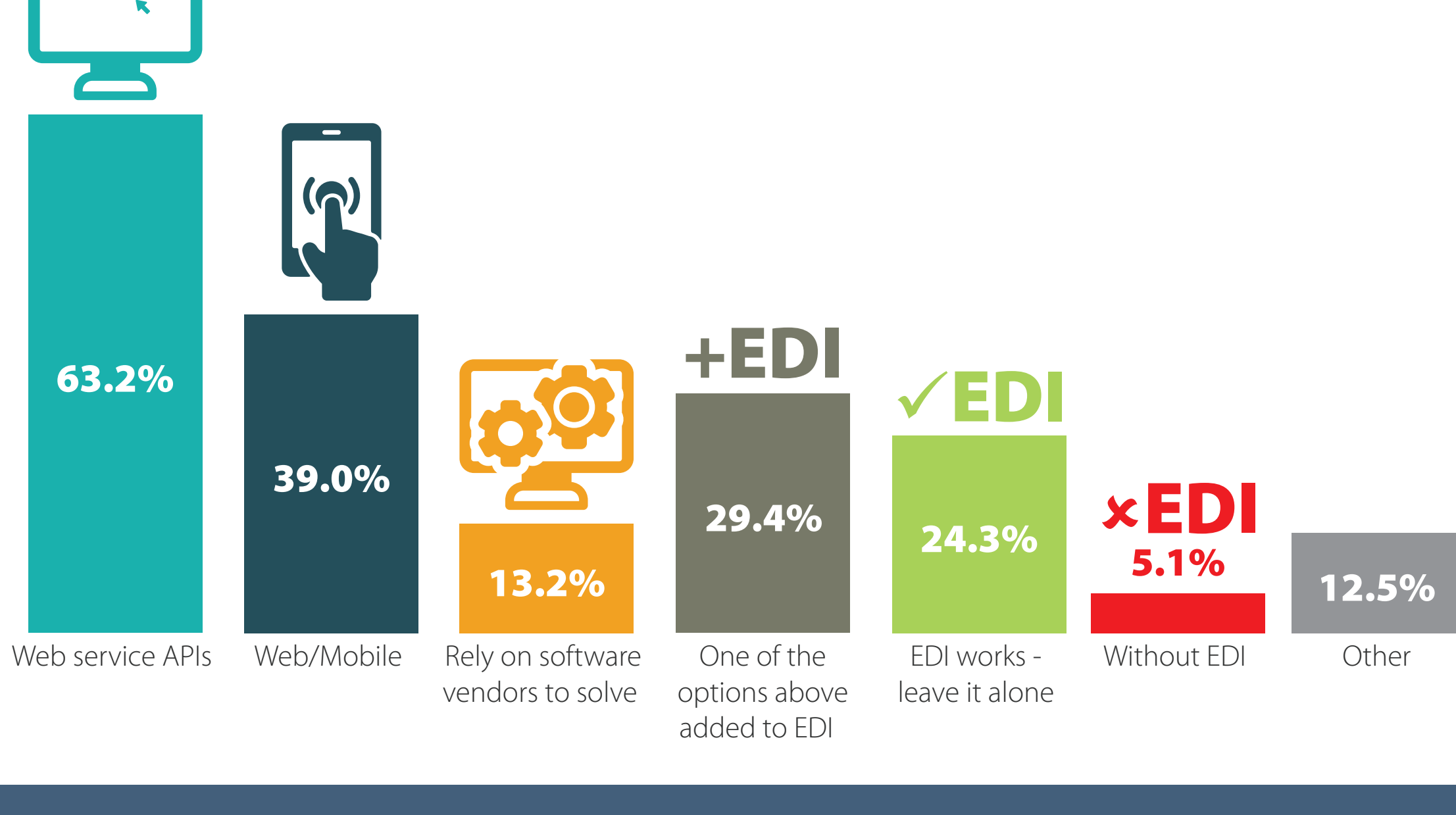
